

Challenge sheet

SPRI

How could **the impact of EJ-GV/SPRI funding programmes be assessed, based on automatically extracting internal data, their display and analysis – along with the integration of unknown external sources – in order to identify trends and generate conclusions?**

Sub-challenges:

- How could the obtaining and organising of the available information be automated?
- How could past and present data be viewed and analysed?
- How could external data be included in past and present analyses in order to identify trends and generate conclusions?

Background:

SPRI as an RDA (Regional Development Agency) manages funding programmes in different areas. The main goal of the challenge is for the measuring of the impact of those programmes to be automated based on analytical models.

An annual static report, focused on measuring indicators and limiting the reach of the "impact assessment", is currently used for the analysis.

Goals:

We are seeking solutions that comply with at least one of these goals, namely to:

- Exploit the available information in as automated manner as possible.
- Interact with the information and use it for different types of analysis.
- Incorporate other useful external information for impact assessment.

What are we looking for?

The following aspects will be considered:

- Whether it is easy to implement
- Whether it can be used by different profiles according to their tasks or responsibilities.
- Whether it is an automated solution and provides real time data.
- Whether it impacts the whole data value chain.

Process and key dates:

- The deadline to receive the response to the proposal is: 23:59 hours on 02/05/2024
- The semi-finalist startups will be notified on 10/05/2024.

- The finalist startups will be notified on 24/05/2024.
- The winning startup will be notified on 13/06/2024.

The selection process consists of 3 phases:

1. **Phase 1:** semi-finalists' pitches with society. Three startups will be shortlisted as finalists. They will take place from 16 to 24 May 2024.
2. **Phase 2:** round of finalists' interviews with the company. They will take place in the week starting 27 May 2024.
3. **Phase 3:** final meeting with finalists to select the winning startup for the pilot scheme with the company. It will be held between 11 and 12 June 2024, during the acceleration programme.

What are the rewards?

Finalist startups (3)

- **2-day govtech** acceleration programme. It will be held in-person in Bilbao on 11 and 12 June.

Winning startup

- **Presentation of the solution at the 2024 BIND GovTech Demo Day**, in-person in Bilbao.
- **Remunerated pilot** up to a maximum of €15,000. The pilot to implement the winning solution will begin in July 2024 and will last 5 months.
